AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AN ENVIRONMENTAL  
COMMISSION IN THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING AND  
SUPPLEMENT THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES  
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING 1973"

Section 1. Chapter 2, Administration Section 2-30,  
Environmental Commission.

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey, there is hereby created an environmental commission consisting of seven members, appointed by the Mayor, one of whom shall also be a member of the Planning Board, and all of whom shall be residents of the Township of Ewing and shall be selected on the basis of their qualifications and fitness for service on the commission.

Section 2. Chapter 2, Administration Section 2-30.1,  
Powers of Commission.

The environmental commission organized under this act shall have power to conduct research into the use and possible use of the open land areas of the municipality and may coordinate the activities of the unofficial bodies organized for similar purposes, and may advertise, prepare, print and distribute books, maps, charts, plans and pamphlets which in its judgment it deems necessary for its purposes. It shall keep an index of all open areas, publicly or privately owned, including open marshlands, swamps and other wetlands, in order to obtain information on the proper use of such areas, and may from time to time recommend to the Planning Board or to the Mayor and governing body of the municipality plans and programs for inclusion in a municipal master plan and the development and use of such areas.

Section 3. Chapter 2, Administration Section 2-30.2,  
Chairman of Commission.

The Commission shall designate one of its members to serve as its chairman and presiding officer, provided however, that that member shall not be the Planning Board member on the commission.



Section 4. Chapter 2, Administration Section 2-30.3,  
Terms of Office.

Two members of the commission other than the Planning Board member shall be appointed for a term of one year and until the appointment and qualification of their successors; two members other than the Planning Board member shall be appointed to serve for a term of two years and until the appointment and qualification of their successors; and two members other than the Planning Board member shall be appointed to serve for a term of three years and until the appointment and qualification of their successors. All subsequent terms thereafter shall be for a period of three years. The term of the Planning Board member of the commission shall be one year and until the appointment and qualification of his successor.

Section 5. Chapter 2, Administration Section 2-30.4,  
Removal.

The Mayor may remove any member of the commission for cause, on written charges served upon the member and after a hearing thereof at which the member shall be entitled to be heard in person or by counsel.



Section 6. Chapter 2, Administration Section 2-30.5,  
Vacancies.

A vacancy on the commission occurring otherwise than by expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as an original appointment.

Section 7. Chapter 2, Administration Section 2-30.6,  
Compensation.

The members of the commission shall serve without compensation.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
